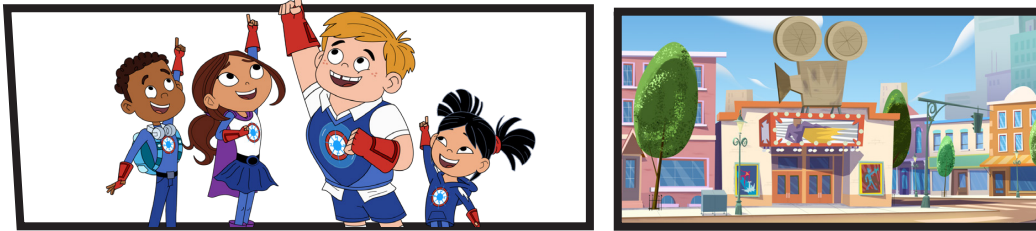


SCIENCE IS SUPER!
